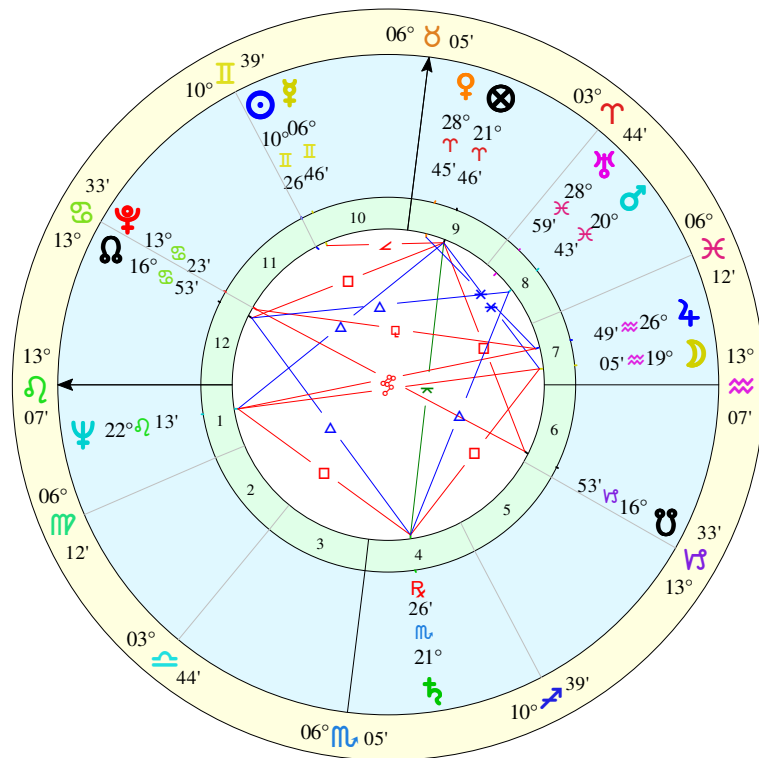

Family and Friends

The Moon

The Moon tells you about your children's emotional nature and basic needs. It is also the key to how they experience intimacy in relationships. The Moon tells you about your children's relationship with their mother, how they experience their mother's nurturing. As a result it can also give you insights on how to best nurture your children as babies and maturing young adults. When a child feels safe and has their basic needs met, they are better able to achieve their goals later in life.

The Moon is in Aquarius

Marilyn is unpredictable from birth. Life is topsy-turvy when young Marilyn enters the world. A delightful and charming child, Marilyn ensures that life is fun and unpredictable. If adults try to adhere to a routine, little Marilyn simply makes loud protesting cries, particularly if she is bored. This child needs stimulation. As a young child, Marilyn is impulsive and gregarious, enjoying socialising with other children and with adults. Marilyn loves company. Marilyn is intelligent. She is also inventive and curious about how things work. Therefore she will ask lots of questions and enjoys toys such as Lego(r) or simple engineering models. Young Marilyn may prove to have quite a temper, particularly in conflicts with her mother. Marilyn does not respond well to discipline, preferring to be left to her own devices. The Moon is in the 7th House

Either way this bond with her mother is likely to have an important influence on her life and relationships. A nourishing, loving union with mother results in a confident and charming child. Venus

Venus is in Aries

This is because young Marilyn likes to take over in her friendships and family relationships. There is a tendency for bossiness and wilfulness, and therefore an inability to co-operate with other children. The Sun

The Sun represents your child's identity. It describes your child's basic personality traits and their talents. It also tells you how your children think of themselves; how they need to express themselves; how they need to shine in their lives; how they feel alive. It is the centre of a child's self-expression. The Sun can also tell us about a child's father.

The Sun is in Gemini

Curiosity is central to the nature of a Gemini Sun sign. The natural curiosity of an infant is magnified in Marilyn's nature. Parents may have difficulty keeping up with Marilyn's need for exploring everything and everyone in her environment. Marilyn enjoys the company of other people as long as they are communicating with her. The Ascendant

Wouldn't it be ideal if we could isolate one trait in our personalities, capture it in a glass for observation and dissection? Of course this is not possible. Neither is it possible for us to isolate one part of a birth chart. The different aspects of our children's birth charts intermingle in a complex manner to make the little person that we know and love. However, it is possible for us to influence the development of our children, to support them in their journey. The aim of this section is to give vital clues for parents and mentors on how to guide, but not coerce, the development of your child.

Jupiter is Conjunct The Moon

Marilyn is an amiable baby and a co-operative child. She finds pleasure in her relationship with her parents, in particular her mother or another mother figure in her young life. As a result young Marilyn is socially secure and feels that the world is a bountiful place. Marilyn enjoys pleasing other people, especially important women in her life.
